"Responsible innovation is a transparent, interactive process by which societal actors and innovators become mutually responsive to each other with a view to the (ethical) acceptability, sustainability and societal desirability of the innovation process and its marketable products (in order to allow a proper embedding of scientific and technological advances in our society)"

A few problems: Top-down definition, Developed by researches and politicians, Mainly applies to tech innovation, Complicated and costly for enterprises

# RRI dimensions, keys, objectives and "sister" concepts





Anticipation (envision the future) – Reflexivity (scrutinize your approach and beliefs) – Inclusion & Deliberation (engage stakeholders and enable them to participate) – Responsiveness (willingness and capacity to change along the way)

Public engagement – Open access – Gender – Ethics – Science education – Governance
